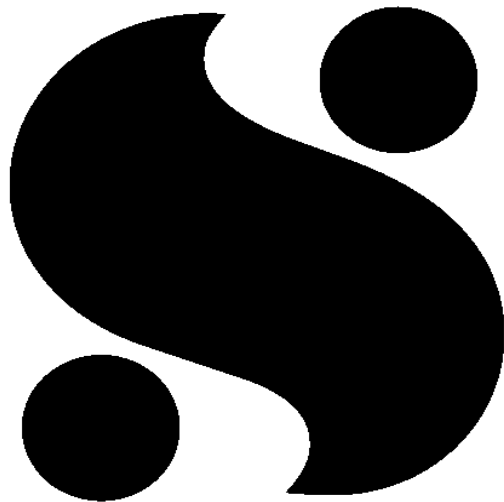

## To register for classes at Sitar Arts Center, students must:

1. live in Washington, DC
2. make a registration appointment by calling 202-797-2145 or email [register@sitarartscenter.org](mailto:register@sitarartscenter.org).

## All registering students must bring a:

1. parent or guardian (for students between 5 and 18).
2. current school report card.
3. \$15 registration fee (all other fees, if any, will be assessed at time of registration).

## Students may not register if:

1. a recent report card is not provided.
2. the student has an outstanding balance from a previous semester.

Any student/family with concerns about tuition can discuss the possibility of a payment plan when registering.  
No student will be turned away because of inability to pay.

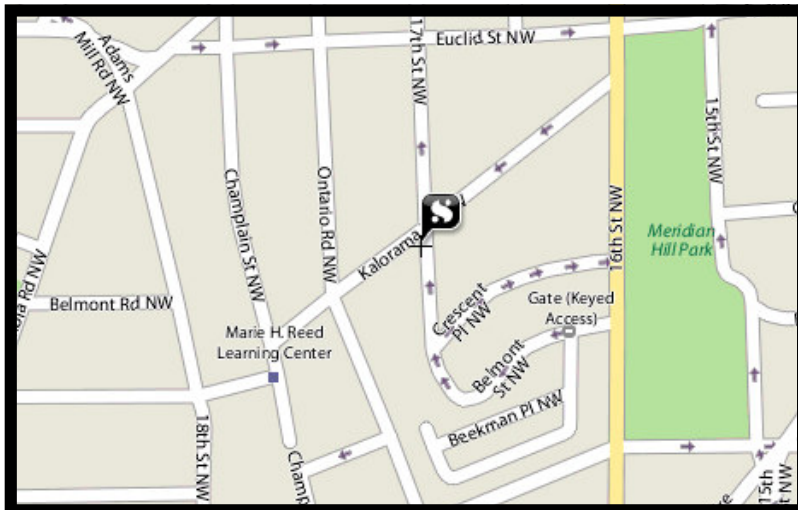

## **ART II—Loretta Thompson, Instructor**

(Wed. 5:30pm - 7:00pm, ages 10 to Adult)

This is an intermediate skills class that builds on skills from ART I in painting, drawing, two dimensional, and three dimensional art forms. Students complete projects in these areas while learning about realism, abstraction, cubism, pointillism, portraiture, perspective, foreground, background, depth of perception, focal points, shading, contour, form, and movement. Permission of instructor required.

## **GLEE (Cathedral Choral Society) - Daniel Ozment, Instructor**

(Mondays, 5:00pm - 6:00pm, ages 9 to 12)

Participants in this glee club explore all styles of vocal music, including classical, jazz, gospel, and Broadway/pop. They will also learn ensemble singing techniques which will be used often in the summer musical and classes such as Musical Theater Workshop.

## **Jazzin' at Sitar (DC Jazz Festival) - Herman Burney, Instructor**

(Wednesdays, 6:00pm - 7:00pm, ages 9 to 18)

Participants in this class will experience a jazz ensemble experience courtesy of the DC Jazz Festival. Students will learn the improvisational fun and surprise of jazz, some jazz history, and discover how to experience music as a source of personal enrichment and as a vehicle for constructive human expression!

## **Instrument Expert - Trisha Taylor, Instructor**

(Thursdays, 5:00 - 6:00pm, ages 8-12)

Students will begin to learn one or two instruments in a group setting. Perfect for students with little to no experience with instrumental music.

## **Music Production Lab—Rob Smith, Instructor**

(Fridays, 4:00—5:00 pm, ages 12-18; permission of instructor)

Students with experience in Music Production I or II can sign up for creative lab time to work on their projects under the guidance of instructor Rob Smith.

## **Mosaics—Sophia Krentzman, Instructor**

(Mondays, 4:00—5:00 pm, ages 9-12)

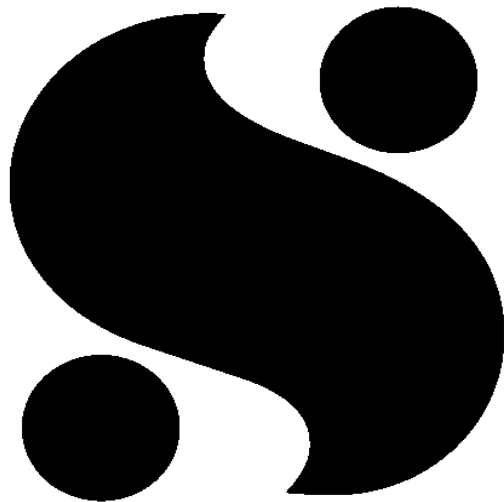
