Production Manager/Stage Manager for Summer Musical @ Camp Sitar

The position includes both production management duties (ex. facilitating and supervising shop hours (with designers and volunteers) and production meetings to see that production elements are completed) and stage management duties for the show.

Candidates should have at least 3 years of experience in production management and/or theater stage management, musical theater and technical theatre. Ability to read music desirable. Previous experience teaching/and or working with youth is highly desirable. Some evenings and weekends will be required for technical work.
