

1.5 | TB TEST

Because it is in the best interest of our children and because our insurance company and some of our funders require it, all staff and volunteers working with children must get screened for TB. You may have the TB test performed by your own physician or visit one of the area locations listed below. Once you have completed the test, please bring in a copy of the certification that you are TB free. The test needs to be repeated every year.

Sitar Arts Center is happy to reimburse you for the cost of this annual test up to \$50. Please turn in your receipts to the Director of Faculty and Education.

Please Note: Getting a TB test requires two visits to any facility. On the first visit, the clinic will administer the test; then a 48 hour waiting period is required to see if there is a reaction. The patient must return 48 hours later to have the test read. (If the patient does not return in the proscribed amount of time the test will be invalid and will have to be repeated.)
