1. Parent or guardian (for students under 18) and all students registering
2. Form of payment for registration fee and a portion of class fees (fees will be assessed at time of registration)
3. Copy of 2015 tax return

# Instrumental Music Academy

Private Music Lessons

**Sitar's private music lessons are only available to students who are in the 2nd grade AND 7 years old through 12th grade, who've taken Sitar classes previously.**

Students are selected for lessons in the following order:

- Returning private lesson students
- Returning Sitar Arts Center students

To fill open private lessons, Sitar staff consider students in the order in which they register on the interest list. The lesson interest list is not an ongoing waitlist. **Students must register for the interest list each semester to be considered for a private lesson.**

Sitar staff also consider factors such as behavior, maturity, respect for property, and regular attendance to other Sitar classes when selecting students for lessons. Sitar does not offer private music lessons for adults.

# Arts Afterschool

## Kindergarten - 1st Grade

All ECA classes are for a parent/caregiver and child except for those marked with a star (\*) which are for children alone.

These classes are available to kindergarteners as part of the Arts Afterschool program, so the registration process is different than for Early Childhood Arts classes.

To register for these classes, you must:

- Speak to a Sitar Early Childhood Arts Staff Member about how to register.
- To qualify for our sliding fee scale, you must bring a copy of your 2015 tax return to your appointment.
- Kindergarten students do not need to attend the registration appointment, however, all students in 1st grade and older must attend the registration appointment.

All teens who are interested in community service, must register as a Sitar student for at least one teen arts class at Sitar AND register for “Community Service Job” during their registration time. A community service job (serving as an assistant for an arts class for younger ages, or serving as a lobby assistant) will then be assigned during the registration appointment. Community service is a weekly commitment for one to two hours per week for the duration of the semester with specific assigned hours. Community service students can accumulate 15 - 30 hours each semester. Students are responsible for tracking their own community service hours. Make-up hours are not generally available and may not be scheduled directly by the student. Additional hours may be accrued at special events and are assigned at the discretion of the Senior Director of Programs or the Student Affairs & Outreach Manager.
